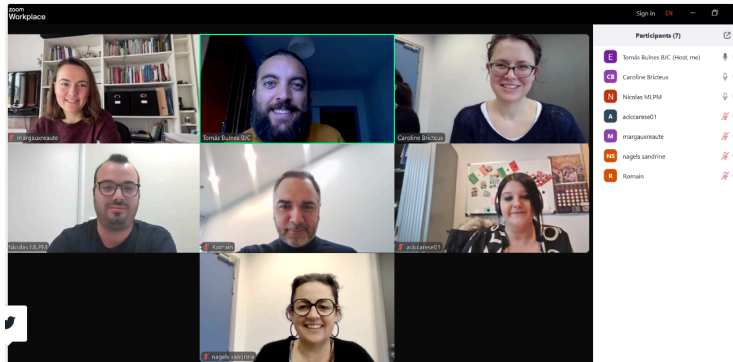
# Terremplo Final Conference - Ballymun Civic Centre
